Synopsis

Act I

Scene I

In front of the temple Solor, a brave warrior, wishes to present a tiger-skin to the Rajah, and sends his friends off to the hunt. He remains near the temple in order to secretly meet his beloved Nikiya, one of the bayadères who guard the sacred fire. He plights his troth to her. The Grand Brahmin, also in love with Nikiya, discovers them together and becomes terribly jealous.

Scene II

In the Rajah's palace


The Rajah offers the hand of his daughter, Gamzatti, to Solor. Bound by his vow to Nikiya, Solor does not want to accept, but is obliged to obey the Rajah. The Grand Brahmin comes to tell the Rajah of the secret relationship between Solor and Nikiya. Gamzatti overhears their conversation, and has Nikiya brought to her so that she can tell the bayadère of her own engagement to Salor. Nikiya refuses to believe that Solor would break his vow. The two rivals quarrel. Nikiya threatens Gamzatti with a dagger, but the princess's servant prevents her from striking. Gamzatti longs for the removal of the impertinent bayadère.

Act II

The betrothal of Solor and Gamzatti
Whilst the celebrations take place,
Nikiya is brought in to dance before the
guests. Aiya, Gamzatti's maidservant,
presents the bayadère with a basket of
flowers. Hidden inside is a serpent,
which bites Nikiya fatally.
The Grand Brahmin intervenes and
offers Nikiya an antidote to the poison
if she will accept his love. Realising that
Salor will not renounce Gamzatti,
Nikiya refuses the antidote and dies,
invoking the wrath of the Gods upon
those who are responsible for her death.

Act III

The Kingdom of the Shades
Devastated by Nikiya's death, Solor
seeks refuge in opium-induced dreams.
A ghostly procession of dead bayadères
appears to him in a long hypnotic
vision: amongst them is Nikiya, who
grants him her forgiveness.
